

### DRESS CODE & NOTES

(Please note: all who have tickets, dancing or not, please follow dress code)

<u>Men</u>: This dance requires semi-formal to formal attire. If you are in doubt, err on the formal side. Dress slacks, shirt, and tie are appropriate. (sorry, no jeans!)

A dress jacket may be added for a complete outfit. Kilts are a welcomed sight tool

#### Ladies:

Dresses are to be mid-calf or longer with a full skirt that does not drag on the floor.

(Comfortable shoes help, and no shoes are fine too)

- The front of your dress must come up on the sides to your underarms, and the back must come up to the bra line..
- Dresses need to have straps (you are moving a lot, and we want you to be comfortable, not embarrassed)
- Make sure that the dress is covered in front so that nothing shows
- A shawl is a good compliment, just remember it gets warm
- We do not allow V front dresses that go lower than armpit level
- You can also wear a jacket, sweater, or shawl
- There will be chaperones happy to help you and will be wearing name tags. (also with any repairs as there will be safety pins, thread, etc in the lower bathroom)


Upon receiving your registration and check, we will e-mail your confirmation number (within a week)

# HAMILTON -WILLIAMS Campus Center Parking Directions and Wheelchair Access

There is street parking on Rowland Avenue, west of the Campus Center. People in wheelchairs can access the entrance at the east end of Rowland Avenue to the Campus Center.

However, most parking will be off Spring Street on the north side of the Campus Center building itself AND on Park Street and at the campus buildings located just south of the Campus Center off Park Street. The Hamilton-Williams Campus Center has a very distinguishable bright green roof.

If you wish for wheelchair access, instead of turning left onto Spring Street, go another 1/2-1 block to Rowland Avenue and turn left at the "T" there at Rowland Avenue, this puts you at the west end of the Campus Center building.

If you wish to park on Park Avenue, go south on S. Washington Street, past Spring Street, past Rowland Avenue, turn left onto Park Avenue, and park at the buildings on the south side of the Campus Center or park on Park Avenue.
